Players' Code of Behaviour

- 4. Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully, or take unfair advantage of another player.
- 5. Co-operate with your coach, teammates and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
- 6. Play for the fun of it, and not just to please parents and coaches.
- 7. Never argue with an official.
- 8. Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not acceptable or permitted in any sport.
